In particular, we will remember the many healthcare workers who risked their lives during the Second World War to care for members of the armed forces and civilians injured in bombing raids.

We will commemorate the 80th anniversary of D-Day on 6 June 2024, by lighting our Lamp Light of Peace at 9:15pm that night in remembrance of those who lost their lives and the veterans who served to help protect our freedom.

Our hospital played an important role during the Second World War with the former Norfolk and Norwich Hospital providing treatment to locally stationed troops and American Air Force personnel.

The old N&N suffered damage during air raids in the early 1940s and treated countless casualties in the war. At the time of the D-Day landings, a number of N&N nursing staff were called to hospitals in South East England to help casualties.
